Guidance for Re-opening of the church

Private Prayer

The church will re-open from this Tuesday (23rd) for individual private prayer. The maximum capacity will be 24 people. There will also be 3 stewards and 1 cleaner present at all times. Please follow instructions given by the stewards. You will need to read the notice displayed on the church door (Stop) before entering the church.

In order to comply with current guidelines the following need to be adhered to at all times.

Toilets: will be closed at all times.

Candles: may only be handled and lit by a steward.

Statues, Stations of the Cross: must not be touched.

Hand Sanitiser: to be used on entry and exit of the church.

Face Coverings: Not compulsory but recommended.

Children under 16: are not allowed access to the church without adult supervision.

Social Distancing: must be observed at all times.

One way system: will be in operation.

Stewards: will be present to assist you when entering, throughout your visit and when leaving the church, please follow their instructions.
