Let us pray for the respect and protection of human life in all its stages, recognizing it as a gift from God.

Today is The Solemnity of SS Peter & Paul, Apostles St Peter was one of the twelve Apostles, in today's Gospel we hear Jesus say 'you are Peter and on this rock I will build my Church', (Matthew 16: 13-19) Peter was the first Pope of the Church. St Paul was originally known as Saul he was a Pharisee who often presided over the persecution of Christians. One day on the road to Damascus he experienced a vision after which he converted to Christianity, we hear many of St Paul's letters in our Mass readings. Both saints can be seen on the mosaic on the Sanctuary in our church. St Peter is holding the keys and St Paul is holding the sword and bible.

We welcome and thank Canon Ray Corbett who will celebrate the Saturday 6pm Vigil Mass and Fr Nicholas Latham who will celebrate both Masses on Sunday.
