Every year, the Church throughout the world devotes a day to migrants and refugees. This year, 2022, the day will be celebrated on Sunday 25th September. World Day of Migrants and Refugees has been held annually since 1914 - an indication that displacement from one's homeland has long been a feature of life for many people. This day is an opportunity for Catholics throughout the world to remember and pray for those who are displaced through war, poverty and persecution, and also to raise awareness of the fact that migration offers opportunity for many people. It benefits many. In 2020, Pope Francis, in his message, said, "if we wish to promote those whom we wish to assist, then we must involve them and make them agents of their own redemption". In his message for this year, 2022, the Holy Father expands on those words by choosing the theme 'Building the Future with Migrants and Refugees'.
