NHS Track and Trace - Contact details

For the safety of all who attend Mass the government has advised that a contact phone number be kept (for a period of 21 days) for everyone who comes to Mass. It will be made available to NHS Track and Trace if they contact the parish to request that information. Only one contact number is needed per family/group. If you do not wish to provide your phone number you can still attend Mass. Please bring a piece of paper with their name and phone number (each time you attend Mass) and hand it to the steward, it will be stored in a sealed envelope, then destroyed after 21 days. If you would like to give your details but have not written them down the steward can do this for you. Please be mindful of social distancing if the steward is writing your details. **NHS COVID -19 App** if you have downloaded this app to your mobile phone you can now scan our QR code as you enter church instead of handing in your written details.
