**Synod 2021-2023 - Walking Together**

Pope Francis wants to hear from the whole Church about what is happening in local parishes. He and Archbishop Bernard Longley would like to know what individuals think we should all be doing to help make our parishes better.

The way he has proposed doing this is a synodal process. Synod means 'journeying together' and it involves listening to the Holy Spirit and to each other in order to discern the path we are called to walk together. Walking together is above all a spiritual journey. We are invited to journey together while always calling upon the Holy Spirit to lead and guide us. We are asked to pray constantly. Walking together calls for actions in the short term, but the purpose of the Synod is broader than this: it is an invitation to discern co-responsibly how we are the Church today. Meetings will be held in February to enable us to participate in the discussion and listening process.
