NHS Track and Trace - Contact details

For the safety of all who attend Mass the government has advised that a contact phone number be kept (for a period of 21 days) for everyone who comes to Mass. It will be made available to NHS Track and Trace if they contact the parish to request that information. If you come to Mass as a group/family only one contact number is needed. If you do not wish to provide your phone number you will still be able to attend Mass. With effect from this Saturday (1st August) we would ask anyone coming to any future Mass to bring a piece of paper with their name and phone number (each time they attend). A steward will have a container for you to drop this into. After the Mass the container will be sealed and stored, after 21 days the information will be destroyed. If you would like to give your details but have not written them down the steward can do this for you. Please be mindful of social distancing if the steward is writing your details.

Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are now being celebrated in our churches. In keeping with the government restrictions, the maximum number of people allowed is 30. Parents who have had to postpone their child's baptism should phone the presbytery or preferably email - to rearrange. Baptisms for single families only unless families are closely related.

The times of Baptism will be 12.00 noon on Saturdays or 1.00pm on Sundays by appointment.
