First Holy Communion As we were unable to celebrate first Holy Communions in May this year, it is now proposed to celebrate them during the month of October. It is hoped to hold them on the first four weekends i.e. Saturday/Sunday 3rd/4th 10th/11th 17th/18th 24th/25th at the Saturday morning 10.00am Mass (4 children) Saturday evening 6.00pm Mass (2 children) Sunday 9.00am and 11.00am Masses (2 children at each Mass). To adhere to current regulations there will be a limit of 10 people to each child. Parents will receive a letter from the school with further information and families will be asked to sign up for a particular Mass.

Sacrament of Baptism

Baptisms are now being celebrated. In keeping with the government restrictions, the maximum number of people allowed is 30 and for single families only, unless families are closely related. Baptism will be on a Saturday or Sunday by appointment.

NHS Track and Trace - Contact details

For the safety of all who attend Mass the government has advised that a contact phone number be kept (for a period of 21 days) for everyone who comes to Mass. It will be made available to NHS Track and Trace if they contact the parish to request that information. Only one contact number is needed per family/group. If you do not wish to provide your phone number you can still attend Mass. Please bring a piece of paper with their name and phone number (each time you attend Mass) and hand it to the steward, it will be stored in a sealed envelope, then destroyed after 21 days. If you would like to give your details but have not written them down the steward can do this for you. Please be mindful of social distancing if the steward is writing your details.
