Re-opening of Church for Mass

The good news is that the church will re-open next week-end 4th/5th July for the celebration of public Mass. The Masses will be at the regular times of 6.00pm (Saturday) and 9.00am & 11.00am on Sunday.

Please note that at present **it is not obligatory to attend Mass on Sunday.** Some people may prefer to attend on a weekday morning (9.00am each day Monday to Friday and Saturday at 10.00am) and it is recommended that the elderly or anybody with underlying health problems do not attend.

Based on Government Guidance on the safe opening of Places of Worship there are some restrictions.

Social Distancing must be maintained - for church we can go to "1m plus" which means that we can space people more closely but **compulsory wearing of a face covering applies** - everybody over 5 years of age must wear a face covering.

Households may sit together but otherwise no more than 3 people can sit in any one bench.

Stewards will direct people to their seats - people cannot just choose where to sit. There will be a one-way system in operation - all enter by the main front door and exit the side door by the disabled toilet.

Mass books will not be available and any books or Mass leaflets brought to the church must be taken home (otherwise they will be destroyed)

There will be no music or singing.

Holy Communion will be distributed at the end of Mass and people will leave the church immediately - Holy Communion must be received in the hand with the arm fully stretched to avoid contact with the priest, deacon or minister.

The church has to be completely cleaned and sanitised after each Mass in preparation for the next celebration. If you can volunteer to remain back and help please let us know by email during the week.

We do not know how many parishioners will turn up for each Mass - Fr Sean could be on his own (three months experience) or there could be too many for a particular Mass (have to abide by maximum safe operating capacity).

Any suggestions ?? Maybe an email during the week to say which Mass you hope to attend - it would be especially helpful to hear from families.

We look forward to the celebration of communal Mass again. Please be co-operative and understanding.
